

Joint Tactical Radio System (JTRS) Defense Acquisition Board (DAB)
Information Paper

- The Defense Acquisition Board (DAB), chaired by the Acting Under Secretary of Defense for Acquisition, Technology and Logistics (USD(AT&L)), met on December 1, 2003, for the annual review of the Joint Tactical Radio System (JTRS) program.
- As a result of the DAB review, the Acting USD(AT&L) signed an Acquisition Decision Memorandum on January 21, 2004, directing the following:
 - ASD(NII) will take the lead in formulating a plan for the management of the entire JTRS development, as required by Section 213 of the FY 2004 Authorization.
 - The JPO Director and Cluster Managers will work with the Services to ensure all programs are fully funded.
 - The Air Force and Navy will develop a revised Acquisition Strategy for the Airborne, Maritime, and Fixed (AMF) program, which is a combination of Clusters 3 and 4.
 - The JPO will develop a capstone Logistics Support Plan, providing common sustainment planning for all Clusters.
