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Summary of this ***NEWSLETTER*** information:

The following changes should IMMEDIATELY be incorporated when preparing for a new TPS contract and, if feasible into existing TPS contracts.

11-06 NAVICP POC

Mr. Ed O'Hara is the new NAVICP POC for PSOW requests.

11-07 COST REPORTING

Due to the cancellation of DI-MGMT-81467 COST/SCHEDULE STATUS REPORT (C/SSR), requirements were created for the Direct to CASS and Offload communities.

11-08 STORAGE CASES FOR MARINE CORPS ONLY OTPH

Requirements for Storage Cases added to Section D for those OTPS destined for Marine Corps only use.

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11-06 NAVICP POC

ATTACHMENT 6, PROVISIONING STATEMENT OF WORK (PSOW)

Replace the current Attachment 6 with new Attachment 6 provided as an enclosure to this NEWSLETTER.

11-07 COST REPORTING

ATTACHMENT 1, STATEMENT OF WORK, add the following Enclosure, tailoring note and paragraph 3.2.3.

3.2.3 Cost Reporting.

For Direct to CASS: Add wording that is utilizes the established Cost Reporting methods for that Developer (i.e. Contractor)

For Offload: Add wording that provides the necessary information for the "Development Cost Management" template (Enclosure 5).

11-08 STORAGE CASES FOR MARINE CORPS ONLY OTPH

CONTRACT SECTIONS B-M, SECTION D, replace the current Section D with the following.

SECTION D - PACKAGING AND MARKING

Items 0001 and Option Item 0101 –

OTPS fielded to Navy and Navy/Marine Corps sites shall be preserved, packaged, and packed in accordance with ASTM D 3951-95, Standard Practice for Commercial Packaging. All parts and assemblies, which require special care during packing, handling, or shipping shall be identified and

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marked appropriately. The exterior of the package or shipping containers shall be marked with at least the following information in such a manner that the markings will not be rendered illegible when opened:

- Nomenclature
- Part Number
- Contract Number
- Assembly Date


OTPS exclusively for the Marine Corps shall be packed in Storage Cases equivalent to 3983AS1090. All parts and assemblies, which require special care during packing, handling, or shipping shall be identified and marked appropriately. The exterior of the package or shipping containers shall be marked with at least the following information in such a manner that the markings will not be rendered illegible when opened:

- Nomenclature
- Part Number
- Contract Number
- Assembly Date

In addition to the packaging for shipping, the following is required:

All cable sets shall be stored in circular, padded, zippered cable bags for each OTPS. The cable set bags shall be clearly identified. NOTE: For Marine Corps only OTPS these shall be incorporated into the Storage Cases.

Small OTPH Accessories (e.g. BNC connectors, SMA connectors) shall be packaged in clear storage case (e.g. tackle box). Identify the OTPH nomenclature on the exterior of the case (e.g. Part of Accessory Set, MX-12014/USM-636(V). Display the physical location of the parts by photograph/graphics, quantity and nomenclature on the inside lid of the case. See example below. NOTE: For Marine Corps only OTPS, these shall be incorporated into the Storage Cases.
