It is estimated that the new baseline will not be ready until the December timeframe. PMA260 wants to include the Systems Engineering Technical Reviews (SETRs) required by NAVAIRINST 4355.19D as soon as possible.

Third. It has been suggested that we might use the “track changes” feature as a way to promulgate changes to the baseline. We have been using the “FROM-TO” approach. If you have an opinion on this, let Melissa, Doc and me know. A simple: Keep “FROM-TO” or use “track changes” will be sufficient.
