



## **Memorandum for the Defense Acquisition Excellence Council**

Date: May 20, 2005

Re: Defense Industry Initiative ("DII") Update

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1. In October 2004, the DII presented a one-day focus seminar on "Ethics and Compliance Issues for the H R Professional", in recognition of the special standards of conduct obligations between defense industry personnel and Defense Department personnel. This well-attended event underscored the H R professional's participation in assuring respect for and compliance with these standards of conduct obligations, and in supporting ethics and compliance within their companies.

2. On January 18, 2005, DII representatives met with the Defense Science Board Task Force on Management Oversight in Acquisition Organizations to offer advice and recommendations for improving oversight of integrity in defense acquisition. The DSB Task Force reported the results of its work to the Under Secretary of Defense (Acquisition, Technology, & Logistics) in March 2005.

3. On May 17, 2005, the DII met with the Office of Management and Budget, Acquisition Advisory Panel ("Sec. 1423 panel") to present its views on the ethical vulnerabilities involved in government procurement, especially regarding purchase of commercial services.

4. The DII continues to participate with the Aerospace Industries Association, Supplier Management Council, in presenting workshops for suppliers on developing codes of business ethics and conduct.

5. On June 2 and 3, 2005, the DII will present its 19<sup>th</sup> annual "best practices forum" on business ethics and conduct, at which over 220 defense industry and Department of Defense personnel will share views on current and emerging ethics and conduct issues.

6. The DII has continued its slow but steady growth, now numbering 66 signatory companies. (attachment)
