Request for Nominations for the IRMCO 2004 Individual and Team Awards

The purpose of this memorandum is to solicit your nominations for the Interagency Resources Management Conference (IRMCO) Award. The IRMCO Award is a prestigious award presented each year to an individual and a team. Effective this year, the IRMCO award has a monetary recognition of \$3,000 (individual) and \$5,000 (team). This award is given to those who have *demonstrated exceptional ability to operate across organizational boundaries to improve the Government's services to its citizens.*

This year, these awards will be presented at the 43rd IRMCO at the Hyatt Regency Chesapeake Bay, in Cambridge, Maryland, on September 8, 2004.

Sponsored by the General Services Administration in partnership with the Federal Chief Information Officers Council, the Chief Financial Officers Council, the Federal Acquisition Council, and the Chief Human Capital Officers Council, IRMCO is attended by executives and managers from essentially every Federal agency, along with academia and many state, local, and international government organizations. IRMCO is a focused and unencumbered environment where executives and managers interact to address the important business and information technology topics and issues facing these communities and the Government today.

Nominations for the IRMCO Awards should be submitted by Monday, June 7, 2004, electronic submissions only. Please e-mail your nominations to yvette.gibson@gsa.gov. Submissions should not exceed two pages in length, and should identify the nominated individual or team, and provide the name, organization, and phone number of the person making the nomination. The submission should also specifically address each of the following award selection criteria:

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- (1) Demonstrated leadership in operating across organizational boundaries;
- (2) Willingness and ability to treat obstacles as challenges, and not barriers; and
- (3) Measurable improvements in performance linked to mission objectives/results.
