

Defense Acquisition Pilot Program Consulting Group
CHARTER

I. Objective

The objective of the group is to validate evaluation baseline criteria and metrics relating to the seven programs selected to participate in the Defense Acquisition Pilot Program.

II. Membership

The group, chaired by DUSD(AR), will consist of members from the offices of DoD Comptroller, DoD Inspector General, Defense Contract Audit Agency, Defense Contract Management Command, and Defense Systems Management College, supplemented with other representation from the Office of the Secretary of Defense, other defense agencies and components, as required by the group. An independent consultant from the private sector will be provided to the group in support of its methodology and analysis of the acquisition of commercial items or components and the use of commercial practices by the pilot program candidates.

III. Methodology - The group will:

- A. Review baseline criteria and metrics that have been submitted by program offices cognizant of each of the seven pilot programs for (1) conceptual soundness, and (2) adequacy of supporting data and information.
- B. Work directly with program office personnel, either in the Pentagon or at program office locations, to provide advice and resolve potential problems concerning the adequacy of data and information supporting baseline criteria and metrics for overall pilot program evaluation.
- C. Prepare an analysis containing the opinion and recommendations of the group concerning the baseline criteria and metrics of each of the seven pilot programs in terms of (1) conceptual soundness, and (2) adequacy of supporting data and information.

IV. Timetable - The timetable for completion of steps A-C is scheduled as follows:

Step A:	April 30, 1994
Step B:	June 30, 1994
Step C:	August 30, 1994

V. Follow-up Activity

At the request of the DUSD(AR), the group will consult on issues concerning baselines and measurements that arise during the course of execution of the pilot program.
