




Electronic PIPC (1662 Phase-out Time Line)



- June 2005 Electronic PIPC IOC
 - Production data load capability in Registry for legacy
 - Registry capable for voluntary Government property data submission
- June 2005 Publish detailed 1662 criteria and instructions
- August 2005 Notify contractors of DD Form 1662 transition to IUID Registry alternative [DCMA / FEDBIZOPS]
- September 30, 2005 All contractors – FY 05 DD Form 1662 report
 - final DD Form 1662 for contractors that transition to IUID Registry
- January 1, 2006 All new Government property meet UID requirements – requires DFARS change
- May 31, 2006 All Government property data in IUID Registry from voluntary contractors (notice to DCMA, requesting block change mod and validating reconciliation)
- September 30, 2006 All DD Form 1662 reporting eliminated



UID Registry/1662 timeline (2005-2006)



- Volunteer Contractors must complete 1662 reconciliation no later than May 31, 2006
- Data on all PIPC must be contained in registry prior to reconciliation

 GM (GF) and GM (CA)

 Standard Submission of All Government Property on DD Form 1662, as of September 30, 2005
