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A Prime's Perspective of Current State

PMO #1

- ✓ No Construct Mandate
- ✓ Mil-Std 130M
- ✓ Does not direct additional data elements beyond DFARS
- ✓ No specific label/marketing format
- ✓ Contractor & Depot Pre-DFARS determination of IUID Parts

PMO #2 (legacy)

- ✓ Mandate Construct
- ✓ Mil-Std 130 L Tailored
- ✓ Specific label/marketing format
- ✓ Asks Contractor to Determine IUID Parts
- ✓ No virtual UII
- ✓ Additional Data Elements Beyond DFARS

PMO #3

- ✓ Preferred Construct
- ✓ Mil-Std 130 K or L
- ✓ Specific label/marketing format
- ✓ Use Virtual UII
- ✓ Additional Data Elements Beyond DFARS
- ✓ Drawing Changes Required

Prime #1

Sub #1

- ✓ No Construct Mandate
- ✓ Latest Mil-Std 130 Version
- ✓ Does not direct additional data elements beyond DFARS
- ✓ No specific label/marketing format
- ✓ First Article Inspection Required
- ✓ Automated Input of data to Prime

Sub #1

- ✓ Mandate Construct
- ✓ Mil-Std 130 L Tailored
- ✓ Specific label/marketing format
- ✓ No virtual UII
- ✓ Additional Data Elements Beyond DFARS
- ✓ Written Notification of Validation Per Item

Sub #1

- ✓ Preferred Construct
- ✓ Mil-Std 130 K or L
- ✓ Specific label/marketing format
- ✓ Use Virtual UII
- ✓ Additional Data Elements Beyond DFARS
- ✓ Drawing Changes Required
- ✓ Manual Input of data to Prime

✦ Contract Structure	Training - Common Structure	OSD/DCMA?	High
✦ Performance Requirements... not process requirements			
✦ No construct preferences or mandates			
✦ Latest version of MIL-STD 130 incorporated in solicitation/contract via SPI or Change			
✦ No program specific label/marketing format, no drawing changes mandates			
✦ No additional data elements relating to IUID beyond the DFARS			
✓ Commonality in Prime/Sub Flowdown to Sub/Sub-Tiers			
✦ IUID SOW and/or RFP Structure			
✦ Performance Requirements... not process requirements			
✦ No construct preferences or mandates			
✦ No program/Prime specific label/marketing format, no drawing changes mandates			
✦ Automated supplier to Prime data transfer			
✦ Validation requirements			
• First Article Inspection and Supplier Process Certification			
• Sampling of Validation Process is a MIL-STD Requirement
