Ms. Moy is the Project Manager for the new DFARS Transformation Integrated System (DTIS). She also serves as a Case Manager in the Defense Acquisition Regulations (DAR) Directorate for issues concerning Information Technology, and Simplified Acquisition.

Ms. Moy started her Government career in 1979 as a Contracting Intern with the Department of Energy. In 1980, she transferred to the Naval Sea Systems Command (NAVSEA) as a Contract Specialist and worked on major acquisitions for shipboard electronics and radar systems. In 1986, she became the Contracting Officer for radar systems and displays, and a year later became the Supervisory Contracting Officer for the Standard Displays and Signal Processors Section. Ms. Moy began her service in the Office of the Secretary of Defense in 1989 as a Procurement Analyst. She was the focal point for electronic commerce, procurement standard data, technical data rights, and government property.

Ms. Moy graduated from George Washington University with a BA in Public Affairs and an MBA in Procurement and Contracting. She has earned recognition as a Certified Professional Contracts Manager (CPCM) from the National Contract Management Association (NCMA) and is Level III Certified in Contracting for the Defense Acquisition Corps.
