


## Edward Douglas Walker, Jr. (Doug)



### Experience:

Since August 1997, Mr. Walker has served as Chief, Weapon Systems Support/ Initiatives, Headquarters (HQ), Defense Logistics Agency (DLA). His division is the HQ DLA point of contact (POC) for the Military Services' initiatives for improving logistics support of weapon systems. The division works with Military Services' Weapon System Program Managers, Contractors, the DLA Defense Supply Centers, the Defense Distribution Center, and the Defense Logistics Information Service on Military Service weapon system support initiatives to: assess potential impact on DLA; secure a best value DLA support role; and, help the lead centers in planning and implementing changes that may be necessary in DLA supply chain practices/processes and methods of support to include tailored support arrangements. He facilitates resolution of policy concerns/problems and other issues raised by DLA field activities, the Military Services, and the Office of the Secretary of Defense (OSD) on weapon system support initiatives. He served as the leader of a DLA IPT that developed a strategy and guidelines for DLA engagement/support of the Military Services' weapon system support initiatives such as contractor logistics support (CLS), performance based logistics (PBL), reduction of total ownership cost (R-TOC), and product support reengineering pilot programs. His division identifies and proposes the need for, and develops new or revised policy and tools to facilitate engagement and support of the Military Services' weapon system support initiatives. He represents DLA on the Department of Defense (DoD) R-TOC Working Group, the DoD Logistics Functional Integrated Product Team (FIPT), the DoD Total Life Cycle Systems Management Executive Council, the DoD/Industry Executive PBL Tiger Team, and the DoD/ Industry planning teams for the PEO/SYSCOM Commanders' Conferences and PM Workshops.

Mr. Walker has 31 years of experience as a manager, supervisor, Supply Management Specialist, Procurement Analyst, and Quality Assurance (QA) Specialist in DoD Components— 18 years as a GM-15. He has served in positions with the: Defense Contract Administration Services (DCAS) Region, Atlanta, GA; DCAS Management Area, Atlanta, GA; the Army Materiel Command QA Field Activity, Lexington, KY; the USAF Aeronautical Systems Division, Wright Patterson AFB, OH; Headquarters, Defense Contract Management Command; Headquarters, Army Materiel Command; and, Headquarters, Defense Logistics Agency.

Mr. Walker graduated with high honors from the University of Louisville in 1972 with a BA Degree in Economics. He received a Masters Degree in Management and Supervision (Business Management) from Central Michigan University in 1981.
