SUBJECT: National Disability Employment Awareness Month and the AbilityOne Program

Congress has designated October as National Disability Employment Awareness Month (NDEAM). This year's NDEAM theme, "Because We Are EQUAL to the Task," recognizes that workers with disabilities have tremendous capabilities and skills. NDEAM is an excellent opportunity to recognize the contributions of employees with disabilities and to celebrate the 75th Anniversary of the AbilityOne[®] Program, which enables nearly 50,000 Americans who are blind or have other significant disabilities to have meaningful employment through Federal contracts. AbilityOne assists more than 3,000 wounded warriors and service-disabled veterans with training and employment, enabling them to continue serving our Nation and the defense mission.

The Department of Defense has a long history of partnering with AbilityOne and remains the largest customer of the Program, procuring more than \$1.7 billion of quality products and services in FY 2012. In this environment of budget uncertainty, your continued support of the AbilityOne Program is extremely important and has a direct and positive result of creating job opportunities for individuals with disabilities. I challenge our acquisition professionals to further increase the use of AbilityOne sources to satisfy procurement needs in accordance with the Federal Acquisition Regulation, Subpart 8.7, and to facilitate new prime contract opportunities.

The acquisition professionals identified in the attached list were recognized over the past year for demonstrating commitment in action to increasing business with AbilityOne. On this 75th Anniversary, I congratulate these award recipients and express appreciation to our acquisition workforce for its steadfast support of AbilityOne.
