

**SUBPART 225.78—ACQUISITIONS IN SUPPORT OF GEOGRAPHIC
COMBATANT COMMAND'S THEATER SECURITY COOPERATION
EFFORTS**

225.7801 Policy.

See DoD Class Deviation [2013-O0020](#), issued October 1, 2013. The class deviation applies to solicitations and contracts with an estimated value in excess of \$100,000 that are being, or will be, performed in the USCENTCOM theater of operations and that will be awarded on or before December 31, 2014. The class deviation requires Senior Procurement Executives to develop a standard process for distributing the USCENTCOM Commander's section 841 notification memoranda to the Heads of Contracting Activities and have their HCAs develop similar mechanisms for providing section 841 notifications to prime contractors performing contracts in the USCENTCOM theater of operations. In addition, the class deviation requires contracting officers to check the "NDAA FY12 Section 841 Identified Entities" information posted on the USCENTCOM website at <http://www2.centcom.mil/sites/contracts/SiteAssets/Contracting.aspx> prior to the award of a contract and periodically during contract performance to ensure that no existing contract being performed in the USCENTCOM theater of operations is associated with individuals or entities on the "NDAA FY12 Section 841 Identified Entities" list. Contracting officers must require prime contractors performing in the USCENTCOM theater of operations to periodically check the USCENTCOM website to ensure that no subcontract is associated with an individual or entity on the "NDAA FY12 Section 841 Identified Entities" list. Class deviation 2013-O0020 expires on December 31, 2014.

See DoD [Class Deviation 2012-O0005](#), Class Deviation—Prohibition on Contracting with the Enemy and Access to Contractor and Subcontractor Records in the U.S. Central Command Theater of Operations, dated January 26, 2012. This deviation is effective until incorporated into the DFARS or is otherwise rescinded.
