The Intertribal Information Technology Company, LLC (IITC) is pleased to participate in to the Federal Acquisition Regulatory (FAR) Council's Tribal consultation process regarding implementation of Section 811 of the National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 2010.

The IITC was formed in 2003 to help meet the vital requirement within the DoD for the conversion of technical manuals for weapons systems from legacy paper and electronic formats to cutting-edge intelligent formats required by our 21st century military. IITC is the prime contractor on the Native American Document Conversion Program.

Although the Intertribal Information Technology Company cannot outline detailed comments on the implementation of Section 811 at this time, we are submitting this letter to notify the FAR Council that the IITC has reviewed the position of the Native American Contractors Association (NACA) on this issue and that NACA's written and oral comments are representative of the IITC's own views or comments.

Without the clarifications to Section 811 that NACA has proposed, the impact of the implementation of Section 811 will have a dramatic chilling effect on the ability of Native enterprises to contract with the Federal Government.
