Insight Technology was awarded its first contract with the DFARS 252.211-7003 requirement in May 2006. Currently, Insight Technology offers twenty-five discrete products with IUID, and IUID requirements are part of the initial product design process. Insight applies IUID Data Matrix marks to its products using either polymerized acrylic foil tape or through direct marking. Methods used for direct marking include laser etching or engraved laser plates that are applied to the system with epoxy.

Insight Technology Incorporated was founded in 1988 on the belief that a company that develops and produces reliable, high quality products that are attractively priced and delivered on time will gain the repeat business of its customers and become successful.

Now with over 1,200 employees, Insight Technology develops and produces highly sophisticated laser aiming and illumination devices, night vision devices, laser rangefinder systems, computerized fire control systems, thermal imaging systems and sensor fusion systems. These products are used by the United States Military and Federal Law Enforcement Agencies.

Insight Technology has achieved many unique milestones while on the IUID journey. For example, Insight was the first company to push XML files to the DoD IUID Registry. In addition, Insight submitted the landmark 1 millionth Registry item in February 2007 as well as the 3 millionth Registry item in April 2008.

The DoD UID Policy Office would like to recognize Insight Technology for its demonstrated leadership in being the first Industry supplier to mark and register over 500,000 Unique Item Identifiers (UIIs) and for its continued support and commitment to progressing IUID beyond compliance.
