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The team successfully implemented the Navy ERP Integration Component and the Navy Legacy Integrations on the NAVSUP FISC Standard Procurement System (SPS) database; this was the first time these two critical interfaces were put into a production environment at the same time.

The FISC SPS Database is the largest SPS database in the Department of Defense, and processes the largest throughput of any SPS database, including over 400 concurrent operational users. Rigorous testing, round the clock support, analysis of lessons learned and attention to configuration management enabled the team to go live with the Navy ERP interface to SPS in October 2008.

Ms. Jannelle Kauk and Ms. Mary Foss led the Standard Procurement System legacy integrations to success through hard work and personal dedication. From far outside the Washington D.C. Beltway in Bremerton WA, these two ladies have traveled several times to the East Coast for SPS integration testing at a great sacrifice to their personal lives. These ladies are fine examples of government personnel at the “deck plate” level who go unrecognized far too often, but who are instrumental and most deserving of being recognized for their efforts.
