Mr. Edward Floyd has been an essential team member to the IUID Registry for many years. He has been involved in the IUID Registry since 2003, the same time as the release of the DoD UID Policy, and he became the Program Manager in 2004.

Ed has 46 years of government service including 21 years in the US Army followed by 25 years of civil service. During his time supporting the IUID Registry, the system has achieved a growth rate of 50,000 new UIIs per week, and presently enables visibility to more than 9 Million DoD items that have been registered in the IUID Registry.
