Ms. Dale Taylor has been extensively involved with Navy eBusiness for over 10 years. She is currently a NAVAIR Standard Procurement System (SPS) Support Lead and SPS Adapter and Technical Representative for the US Navy.

For 9 months, Ms. Taylor led a team to work with Deputy Assistant Secretary of the Navy, Acquisition and Logistics, Maintenance (DASN A&LM) on its Procure to Pay (P2P) initiative, successfully testing a live NAVAIR contract in the P2P process between Navy ERP and MOCAS.

Her efforts on this project have led to great improvements to the P2P process. Her efforts also provided both Navy ERP and SPS managers with recommended Engineering Change Proposals (ECPs) and business rules to further improve the P2P process, ensuring the successful implementation of future Navy ERP instances as well as reducing a workload levels facing DFAS as a result of payment related problems, such as problem disbursements.
