Edmond (Ed) Marceau officially became the Project Manager for the Contractor Performance Assessment Reporting System (CPARS) on December 2, 2001. Since that time Mr. Marceau has led the evolution of the CPARS application from a NAVSEA application to one that is now used by all Federal agencies.

Specifically, in his 11 1/2 years in this position, Mr. Marceau has seen the number of users rise to over 100,000, seen six other duplicative systems be retired, ensured over 100,000 help desk calls were serviced, and trained over 40,000 users. The data collected through CPARS has been used to support tens of thousands of contract source selections. Mr. Marceau's leadership in the area of past performance has been steady and unrelenting. His customer service is unparalleled, and his retirement in June of 2012 will certainly mark the end of a successful career that has truly benefitted the Department.
