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US Navy Workflow Hosting Facility Team

This multi-background team is comprised of members who are either payment, procurement or eBusiness experts in both private industry and government. This team has helped design, program and test a workflow that has been successfully operating since October 2009.

This workflow uses Oracle JDeveloper and Business Process Execution Language (BPEL) to electronically analyze both xProcurement and xDocument Chain, XML, contract data coming from Navy contract writing systems (such as SPS and SEAPORT) for data integrity errors. Accurate and complete data can then be automatically fed into Maintenance Operations Control Center MOCAS and contracts with incorrect data can be reported back to the offices that wrote them for corrective action.

Because of this team's hard work and achievement in this project, the Business Process Execution Language (BPEL) workflow will reduce the Navy's annual Defense Finance and Accounting Service (DFAS) bill for contract payment, improve the Procure-2-Pay (P2P) data quality between Navy ERP and MOCAS, improve the quality of contracts and lessen the burden of manual data entry and CDR generation by DFAS MOCAS payment technicians.
