Since the IUID Policy was introduced in 2003, it has been rapidly implemented by Department of Defense (DoD) Program Managers, Depots, Automatic Identification Technology (AIT) Solution Providers, Government Leaders and DoD Suppliers. Many stakeholders have fully embraced IUID to improve data quality, standardize serialization, and take advantage of automatic data capture to revolutionize existing business processes.

The June 17-18, 2008 UID & eBusiness Forum, held in Sacramento, California, marked the first recognition of the eBusiness Team Excellence Award, presented to Mr. Dan Bryce, Joint Interoperability Test Command (JITC) team lead.

JITC has been involved with UID since 2003, when the UID policy was announced by Mr. Michael Wynne, Acting Under Secretary of Defense, Acquisition, Technology, and Logistics. JITC's contribution to UID includes testing the implementation and recording of UID information in government systems through Wide Area Work Flow (WAWF), and the development of the initial user guides and testing of the X12 and XML submissions. JITC also provided the key connection for communication testing to the UID Registry to include end-to-end testing for all formats. Additionally, JITC has led the testing of the integration services that the Global Exchange (GEX) Service (formerly Defense Electronic Business Exchange (DEBX)) provided in routing, data transmission, communications, audit/archive, and Metrics Mart usage.

“By marking every qualifying asset in DoD inventory and registering the item-level data in a single database, individual users through DoD information systems have access to a globally unique identifier that can be used to track item availability, manage item maintenance history, provide a reliable audit trail, and enhance overall item accountability.” says Dr. James Finley, Deputy Under Secretary (DUSD) for Acquisition and Technology (A&T).

The JITC Electronic Business test team provides developmental, integration, functional, and performance test services in support of DoD UID and electronic business/electronic commerce systems and initiatives. The JITC's “value added” services include production trouble shooting, vendor assistance, training, test environments, and a professional "can do" attitude.
