Your August 6, 2003, memorandum requested that we establish and register a schema for the unique identifiers of our procurement instruments that will be reported to the Federal Procurement Data System – Next Generation (FPDS-NG). The enclosed Defense Federal Acquisition Regulation Supplement (DFARS), Part 204.7000, serves as the Department of Defense's (DoD's) schema. A change, effective October 1, 2003, will require all DoD procurement instruments use the DoD Activity Address Code (DoDAAC) in the first six positions in lieu of the codes currently found in Appendix G of the DFARS. My staff provided a copy of the current regulation and this identified change directly to Mr. John Cochran.
