SUBJECT: Advisory and Assistance Services

Section 834 of the John Warner National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 2007, Public Law 109-364, provides waiver authority to heads of agencies to extend a task order contract entered into under section 10 USC 2304b. However, section 834 also provides that the waiver authority may not be exercised if the specific report on advisory and assistance services required by section 834 is not submitted by April 1, 2007.

The Department was unable to comply with the required submission date for the report. As a result, no waivers may be issued to extend task order contracts for advisory and assistance services pursuant to section 834.
