

SUBJECT: Acquisition of Services Review and Decision Authority

I delegate the authority to establish review procedures and to review and approve acquisitions of services categorized as "USD(AT&L) Special Interest" and acquisitions of services with a total estimated value greater than 1 billion dollars to the Director, Defense Procurement and Acquisition Policy (DPAP). This is in accordance with title 10, United States Code, section 2330, as amended by section 812 of the National Defense Authorization Act for FY 2006, Public Law No. 109-163, and the October 2, 2006, DoD Acquisition of Services Policy memorandum.

The Director, DPAP, will exercise this authority subject to the direction and supervision of the Under Secretary of Defense for Acquisition, Technology and Logistics (USD(AT&L)) and periodically will brief him on the results of these reviews. The Director, DPAP, will inform the USD(AT&L) of any issues requiring his review that Director, DPAP, in consultation with the Deputy General Counsel for Acquisitions and Logistics, has identified before permitting an acquisition to proceed.
