
SUBJECT: Enterprise Business Intelligence in Support of Independent
Verification and Validation (IV&V)

Thank you for your responses to the Defense Procurement and Acquisition Policy (DPAP) memorandum dated February 22, 2008 regarding IV & V. The business intelligence systems / data warehouses you identified can provide detailed procurement information to support the Department's emerging procurement data independent verification and validation (IV&V) efforts in response to Office of Management and Budget (OMB) requirements.

At this time, I ask that Army, Air Force, and Defense Logistics Agency (DLA) provide the Business Transformation Agency (BTA) access by June 30, 2008 to the Army Contract Business Intelligence System (ACBIS), Contract Business Intelligence System (CBIS), and the DLA data warehouse of the Electronic Business Modernization (EBM) suite, respectively, in order to establish a DoD-level enterprise service to collect contract business intelligence data from the Components and perform IV&V. The Army shall also provide access to the data collected for other DoD Components in ACBIS, such as Missile Defense Agency (MDA) and Navy locations now using ACBIS.



Tony Davis, the Program Executive Officer (PEO) for Sourcing Systems in the BTA, will work with your representatives to establish connections in order to read the necessary data from the Components' data warehouses.
