
SUBJECT: Contractor Past Performance Assessment Reporting – 1st Quarter Fiscal Year 2015

The Office of Federal Procurement Policy (OFPP) continues to focus on contractor past performance reporting and is of importance to the USD(AT&L). I am tasked with monitoring and communicating how the Department is performing on a quarterly basis.

The attached spreadsheet identifies the Past Performance Information Retrieval System (PPIRS) compliance metrics as of December 29, 2014, and compares the Fiscal Year (FY) 15 first quarter data of 80.43% against the fourth quarter FY14 data of 79.82% for an increase of less than one percent. The goal for FY15 is 100% compliance.

I appreciate the effort of agencies that have improved their compliance and encourage everyone to do better, especially those that are under 70% compliance, as we have a long way to go to meet the FY15 goal.
