SUBJECT: Rescission of Class Deviation—Reporting Requirement for Prime Vendor Contracts

This memorandum rescinds class deviation 2010-00002. The class deviation was necessary to implement a statutory requirement to prohibit the award of prime vendor contracts for depot-level maintenance and repair of a weapon system or other military equipment prior to 30 days after congressional notification. Section 322 of the National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 2011 (Public Law 111-383) repealed this requirement. Therefore, both the requirement for congressional notification and the requirement for the 30-day waiting period before awarding a prime vendor contract are cancelled.
