SUBJECT: Class Deviation—Removal of Exception to Wide Area Workflow (WAWF) for
Foreign Vendors

Effective immediately, for awards made to foreign vendors for work performed outside
the United States, contracting officers shall not use the exception to WAWF at DFARS
232.7002(a)(2).

This class deviation remains in effect until incorporated in the DFARS or is otherwise
