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

SUBJECT: Rescission of Class Deviation—Contract Obligations in Advance of Fiscal Year
2014 Funding

Effective immediately, Class Deviation 2014-O0001—Contract Obligations in Advance of Fiscal Year 2014 Funding, is rescinded. Class Deviation 2014-O0001 required DoD contracting officers to use the clause at 252.232-7998, Obligations in Advance of Fiscal Year 2014 Funding (DEVIATION 2014-O0001)(October 2013) in order to obtain supplies and services necessary to carry out or support excepted activities in advance of the availability of FY 2014 funds. Use of this clause is no longer authorized.
