SUBJECT: Certifying FY10 Contract Reporting to the Federal Procurement Data System
(FPDS) and Independently Verifying and Validating Reported Data

This memorandum is to remind the components of the December 8, 2010 due date for submission of component certifications of FY10 contract reporting to my office in accordance with the FPDS Contract Reporting Data Improvement Plan version 1.3 posted at http://www.acq.osd.mil/dpap/pdi/eb/federal_procurement_data_system_-_next_generation_fpds-ng.html. Certification packages are required to be signed by the Senior Procurement Executive (delegable) and be inclusive of all procurement activities/offices within their authority. Packages shall include:


1. A completed Agency FPDS Data Quality Certification (Exhibit E from the FPDS Contract Reporting Data Improvement Plan).
2. The FY10 completed validation and verification review results (Exhibit B from the FPDS Contract Reporting Data Improvement Plan).
3. An estimate of the number of FY10 reportable actions and the associated net obligations that have not yet been reported by the date of submission of the package to DPAP, if any.
 - o Include with the estimate the date by which reporting will be completed.
 - o Include with the estimate a description of the corrective plan being put in place within the component to ensure reporting in accordance with the Federal Acquisition Regulation part 4.6 requirements.
 - o Specifically identify in the estimate the number of FY10 orders under blanket purchase agreements (BPA) and basic ordering agreements (BOA) and associated net obligations that can not be reported because the component failed to report the underlying BPA or BOA in a timely manner.
 - o If there are no outstanding reports to be completed, please indicate.

At this time, there are no planned significant changes to the statistical review requirements set out in the existing FPDS Contract Reporting Data Improvement Plan for FY11.

As such, the current plan will be updated for the quarterly review scheduled due dates and suggested new anomaly reports, and be posted at the above website by November 30, 2010. However, please be advised that other data validation requirements may be established in the future for FPDS and / or other reporting systems. Updated component-level FY11 data improvement plans should be submitted no later than December 31, 2010.

DPAP is also putting in place a number of compliance monitoring scorecard reports that track contract data used across different federal and DoD-wide systems. A sample report, which compares the number of contract awards that are reported to FPDS versus the Electronic Document Access system, is attached. This particular report will be used to assess the data provided in the component FY10 certification packages. As this scorecard process matures, components should ensure the results improve from this FY10 benchmark. 
