The following information technology (IT) programs are hereby designated as Principal Staff Assistant (PSA) "special interest" programs within the Real Property and Installations Lifecycle Management Core Business Mission Area for FY 2007 and all future certification cycles.


- Environmental Liabilities
- Real Property Inventory

Component Pre-Certification Authorities will ensure these IT systems, services, applications, and programs implementing environmental liability or real property inventory related activities or processes are reported to the Real Property and Installation Lifecycle Management (RP&ILM) Investment Review Board (IRB) regardless of the amount of planned development/modernization spending on these systems. The investment review process is described in the June 2, 2005, USD(AT&L) memorandum, "Investment Review Process Overview and Concept of Operations for Investment Review Boards," and in subsequent OSD submission guidelines. Additional functional areas may be designated as "special interest" in the future.



The RP&ILM IRB stands ready to meet and review Component investment packages as soon as practicable after receipt of Component submissions. RP&ILM IRB meetings are held monthly.

This memorandum does not supersede the requirements for IT investment approval by the Defense Business Systems Management Council as defined in the Ronald W. Reagan National Defense Authorization Act for FY 2005.
