

NGOR POCs... ISSC Jacksonville is managing the NGOR package in support of PMA-260. The NGOR working group includes team members from ISSC Jacksonville and NAWCAD Lakehurst. Forward comments, questions or requests for copies of the package to: NGOR@navy.mil.

NGOR Use... NAVAIRINST 13630.5 paragraph 4(d) provides policy relating to the PMA260 managed NAVAIR Generic OTPS RFP (NGOR) procurement package on the CASS Family of Testers (FoT). This instruction is for use by all SE Program Offices, Program Managers, Assistant Program Managers Logistics, and other system commands to guide the acquisition and sustainment of ATE and OTPSs. Details for implementation of NGOR are identified in the NAVAIR OTPS Acquisition and Sustainment Process Guide.

SETR Status... NAVAIR INST 4355.19E was formally released on 06 Feb 2015. This updated instruction refines policy, guidance, processes and responsibilities for the planning and conduct of the SETR for NAVAIR programs. The NGOR working group completed the update of the NGOR package to incorporate the changes and updates identified in the new SETR instruction. This revised package allows for tailoring of contract requirements in an effort to more efficiently achieve program objectives. The NGOR package affords the opportunity for the acquisition IPT to customize reviews, processes, and information requirements to accommodate the unique characteristics of a program while still meeting the intent for appropriate decision criteria and oversight processes.

The NGOR package was updated in accordance with the policies identified in the NAVAIR OTPS Acquisition and Sustainment Process Guide and has been submitted for review to PMA-260 prior to release on the PMA-260 website.
