News:

NGOR POCs... ISSC Jacksonville is managing the NGOR package in support of PMA-260. The NGOR working group includes team members from ISSC Jacksonville and NAWCAD Lakehurst. Forward comments, questions or requests for copies of the package to: NGOR@navy.mil.

SETR Status... NAVAIR INST 4355.19E was formally released on 06 Feb 2015. This updated instruction refines policy, guidance, processes and responsibilities for the planning and conduct of the SETR for NAVAIR programs. The NGOR working group is currently updating the February 2015 draft NGOR package to incorporate the changes and updates identified in the new SETR instruction. Additionally, the NGOR package is being updated in accordance with the policies identified in the Acquisition and Sustainment Process Guide which is going through final acceptance.

AUTOTESTCON 2015... The NAVAIR Acquisition team made two presentations at this year’s AUTOTESTCON in Washington Harbor. One of the presentations was entitled *TPS Acquisition* and highlighted current DOD and NAVAIR policy and processes and discussed the challenges in TPS procurement. The presentation further discussed acquisition planning, cost estimating, requirements and risk management, and how such efforts are used to manage TPS procurement programs. The 2nd paper was entitled *Utilizing the SETR Process in Procurement of TPSs on the CASS Family of Testers*. This paper recapped the history of the NGOR package, NAVAIR Systems Engineering (SE) policy, NAVAIRINST 4355.19 SETR policy, and how SE policy (SETR) is being applied to TPS procurement. Emphasis was placed on decomposition of requirements, requirements traceability, and tailoring the application of SETR requirements to ensure programs are right-sized.
