

**Kevin A. Doxey**  
**Director, Strategic Integration**

In this capacity, Mr. Doxey advises senior leaders on matters pertaining to support of Geographic Combatant Commanders (GCCs) contingency management. He is responsible for developing strategic guidance, governance structure and a programmatic approach to institutionalize contingency management across all operational phases, including development of effective metrics. He also is responsible for ensuring a smooth transition of Department of Defense logistical support functions to the Department of State in Iraq; and developing a whole of government approach to partner with Department of State to influence and shape the formation of strategic logistics plans in Afghanistan.



He has over 32 years of experience in the Department of Defense. Previous civilian and military assignments include the Senior Military Advisor to Chairman, Defense Business Board. In this capacity he guided and facilitated reviews, directed by the Secretary of Defense, to obtain a business perspective on national security matters from private sector leaders. Prior to that he served as the Military Advisor to the Deputy Under Secretary of Defense (Logistics and Materiel Readiness) where he provided advice on military matters and protocol covering all branches of the military. He performed direct liaison with the Military Services, Joint Staff, Combatant Commands, other government agencies, and private industry. Mr. Doxey coordinated actions of five staff organizations, including the Defense Logistics Agency.

At the operational level, he served as the Deputy Assistant Director for Afghanistan, in the Strategy, Plans and Policy Directorate of the United States Central Command. There he provided advice to the Combatant Commander and the Commander, Combined Force-Afghanistan on war planning and execution of security and reconstruction operations. Additionally, he coordinated efforts to combat drug trafficking in the Central Asian States and conducted strategic assessments of Iraqi security forces.

While deployed in Afghanistan in 2003, he served as the Director, Afghan Ministry of Defense and General Staff Advisory Team and synchronized reform efforts with Islamic Transitional Government of Afghanistan to establish the Afghan Ministry of Defense.

Mr. Doxey's key leadership positions in the Office of the Secretary of Defense included Director, Environmental Restoration; Director, Environmental Quality; and Executive Secretary for a Defense Science Board Task Force on Improving Fuel Efficiency of Weapon Platforms. During Administration transition he served as an Acting Assistant Deputy Under Secretary of Defense.

Mr. Doxey has a Master of Science in National Security Strategy from the National War College, National Defense University and a Bachelor of Science in Environmental Science from Southampton College, New York. His personal awards include the Department of Defense Medal for Exceptional Civilian Service, Defense Superior Service Medal, Legion of Merit, Bronze Star Medal, Defense Meritorious Service Medal and Army Commendation Medals.
