
MEMORANDUM FOR CHAIRMAN JOINT CHIEFS OF STAFF
THE SECRETARY OF THE ARMY

SUBJECT: Authority to Transfer U.S. Property to Iraqi Ministries

This responds to a request from the Chairman of the Joint Chiefs of Staff to modify the delegation of authority granted on June 15, 2005 to the Commander, Multinational Force-Iraq (MNF-I) and to the MNF-I Deputy Chief of Staff for Resources and Sustainment for the purpose of authorizing transfers of property to Iraqi Security Forces (ISF). I hereby amend that delegation to allow transfers of U.S. property, consistent with the authorities, provisions and limitations of the June 15, 2005 delegation, to other Iraqi Ministries in appropriate cases, in addition to the Ministry of Defense and the Ministry of Interior, with the additional provision and limitations outlined in the paragraph below. These modifications also apply to the original delegation.

This delegation applies only to property no longer required by U.S. Forces in theater, and the authority to transfer property to Ministries other than the Iraqi Ministry of Defense or Ministry of the Interior applies only to property not required by ISF at the time of transfer.

In addition to forwarding a copy of the list of items transferred to the DLA, J-3 or delegate, a copy shall be forwarded to the Deputy Chief of Staff for Logistics for the Military Service that previously had the transferred items on its property books (or in the case of the Army, the Deputy Chief of Staff G-8) or delegate.
