
SUBJECT: DoD Logistics Roadmap

Enclosed are copies of the DoD Logistics Roadmap for you and your senior staff. This initial edition of the Roadmap establishes objectives that add fidelity and detail to the three logistics goals specified in the Guidance for the Development of the Force: Unity of Effort, Visibility, and Rapid and Precise Response. It documents specific actions underway or planned to achieve the objectives. The objectives are linked to three joint logistics capability areas: Supply, Maintain, and Deployment and Distribution,

The Roadmap is a living document that provides a basis for current and future logistics support assessments. This initial edition and future updates will be an integral part of a process of continuous logistics support assessment and feedback linked to the Quadrennial Defense Review and the Planning, Programming, Budgeting, and Execution cycles.

The next step in this continuous process will be an assessment conducted by a joint team of one or more Roadmap objectives within each of the three areas of Supply, Maintain, and Deployment and Distribution. The assessment will determine gaps, shortfalls, overlaps, timing issues, and challenges in achieving improvements.

The Roadmap is the result of collaborative efforts by the DoD logistics community across the Services, Joint Staff, Defense Logistics Agency, US Joint Forces Command, and US Transportation Command.
