52.227-10	Filing of Patent Applications - Classified Subject Matter (Apr 1984)	27.207-2	Whenever DD 254 is used
52.232-20	Limitation of Cost (Apr 1984)	32.705-2(a)	When contract is fully funded
52.242-10 or	F.O.B. Origin - Government Bills of Lading or Prepaid Postage (Apr 1984)	42.1404-2(a)	When FOB origin shipments are to be made using Government bills of lading prepaid postage
52.245-1	Property Records (Apr 1984)	45.106	When contracting office retains administration and Government property is furnished to the contractor, if in Government's best interest
52.245-19	Government Property Furnished "As Is" (Apr 1984)	43.308-2	When Government Property will be furnished "as is" (Basic GP clause required)
52.245-18	Special Test Equipment (Feb 1993)	45.207-3	When contractor will acquire or fabricate special test equipment for the Government but the exact identification of the quipment to be acquired/fabricated in unknown
252.223-7004	Drug-Free Work Force (Sep 1988)	223.570-4	When DD 254 is used or when CO determines it necessary for reasons of national security or to protect health or safety of those affected by contract performance
252.223-7006	Prohibition on Storage and Disposal of Toxic and Hazardous Materials (Apr 1993)	223.7103	All that require, may require, or permit contractor to perform on a DoD installation
252.225-7001	Buy American Act and Balance of Payments Program (Jan 1994)	225.109(d)	For contracts which require the furnishing of supplies
252.225-7002	Qualifying Country Sources as Subcontractors (Dec 1991)	225.109-70(a)	Whenever 52.225-7001 is used
252.225-7008	Supplies to be Accorded Duty-Free Entry (Dec 1991) (In the blanks insert: _____)	225.605-70(a)	When 52.225-10, Duty-Free Entry or 252.225-7009, Duty-Free Entry - Qualifying Country End Products and Supplies are used
252.225-7009	Duty-Free Entry - Qualifying Country End Products and Supplies (Dec 1991)	225.605-70(b)	In contracts which require the furnishing of supplies
252.225-7010	Duty-Free Entry - Additional Provisions (Dec 1991)	225.605-70(c)	When 52.225-10, Duty-Free Entry, is used
252.225-7014	Preference for Domestic Specialty Metals (Dec 1991)	225.7002-4	All contracts which meet or exceed \$25K and require delivery of hand or measuring tools

252.235-7003	Frequency Authorization (Dec 1991)	235.071(b)	When frequency authorization is required
252.239-7000 process	Protection Against Compromixing Emanations (Dec 1991)	239.7102-3(a)	When contracting for computer equipment or systems which are to be used to classified information
252.242-7003	Application for U.S. Government Shipping Documentation/Instructions (Dec 1991)	242.505-14(a)	When 52.242-10, FOB Origin-Government Bills of Lading or Prepaid Postage is used
252.245-7000	Government-Furnished Mapping, Charting and Geodesy Property (Dec 1991)	245.310-70	Only if such property is being furnished to the contractor

52.215-31	Waiver of Facilities Capital Cost of Money (Sep 1987)	15.8904(b)	When contractor does not propose FCCM
52.232-22	Limitation of Funds (Apr 1984)	32.705-2(c)	When contract is fully funded
252.203-7003	Prohibition Against Retaliatory Personnel Actions (Apr 1992)	203.7108	When contract is under \$500K, except for commercial items sold in substantial quantities to general public where price is based on catalog or market prices
252.205-7000	Provision of Information to Cooperative Agreement Holders (Dec 1991)	205.470-2	When contract is under \$500,000
252.225-7026	Reporting of Contract Performance Outside the United States (Apr 1993)	225.7203	When contract is under \$500,000

252.247-7023	Transportation of Supplies by Sea (Dec 1991)	247.573(b)	When contractor proposes direct purchase of ocean transportation services
252.247-7024	Notification of Transportation of Supplies by Sea (Dec 1991)	247.573(c)	When contractor certifies in Section K (DFARS 252.247-7022) that it anticipates supplies will be transported by sea in contract or subcontract performance
