

MARC MEMBERSHIP COMMITTEE CHARTER

(updated April 2011)

The MARC Membership Committee will diligently pursue new Council Members for both categories:

Voting and Non-Voting Associate Members

Voting Members are employees of the Federal Government interested in promoting the Small, Small Disadvantaged, Women-Owned, Hubzone, Veteran-Owned, Service-Disabled Veteran-Owned Small Businesses, HBCU/MI, and Hispanic-Serving Institutions and Tribal College and University Utilization Programs.

Non-Voting Associate Members are Small Business Liaison Officers [SBLOs] for Federal Prime Contracts, Employees of Procurement Technical Assistance Centers [PTACs], Small Business Development Centers as defined in the By-Laws.

This is accomplished through e-mail correspondence and occasional phone calls.

The Membership Committee will develop and maintain a Membership Directory and furnish to the Executive Committee upon request for their use. The Membership Committee will create, distribute, and maintain an informational folder for all attending members at the three yearly MARC meetings.

To keep abreast of membership activities, the committee will interface with other Small Business Education and Advocacy Councils sharing the information obtained with the MARC Executive Committee or the MARC Council Membership as appropriate.
