Abstract

This presentation will discuss the Capability Acquisition Management effort that is using the output of System of System engineering processes to influence the design of systems that are part of a System of Systems. The Capability Acquisition Management effort is influencing the System Engineering Technical Reviews, Analysis of Alternatives, and cost assessments of planned and budgeted acquisition programs to ensure that the operational effectiveness of the System of Systems is considered in these acquisition activities.
