DECISION No. 3/11 PROLONGING THE METHODOLOGY FOR DETERMINING THE MINIMUM HEIGHT ABOVE GROUND LEVEL AT WHICH EACH SENSOR CONFIGURATION WHOSE RESOLUTION DEPENDS UPON HEIGHT ABOVE GROUND LEVEL MAY BE OPERATED DURING AN OBSERVATION FLIGHT

Understanding that OSCC Decision No. 5/07 has worked well with sensor categories containing the optical panoramic and framing cameras and that this Decision is scheduled to expire in December 2011,

The Open Skies Consultative Commission (OSCC) decides to prolong the applicability of OSCC Decision No. 5/07, for a period of 3 years, with a new expiration date of 31 December 2014.

The States Parties shall, within the OSCC and during the period OSCC Decision No. 5/07 is in force, conclude a follow-on agreement on the methodology for establishing H_{\min} based on the experience of completed certifications and demonstration flights.
