Thomas Florip

Supervisor Attorney, Program Executive Office, Tactical Aircraft Programs (PEO(T)) Legal Department, Naval Air Systems Command (NAVAIR)

Mr. Thomas J. Florip is the Supervisor Attorney for the Program Executive Office, Tactical Aircraft Programs (PEO(T)) Legal Department at the Naval Air Systems Command (NAVAIR) in Patuxent River, Maryland, and in that role serves as counsel to PEO(T). PEO(T) provides full life-cycle support of naval aviation aircraft, weapons, and systems operated by sailors and marines. This support includes research, design, development, and systems engineering; acquisition; test and evaluation; repair and modification; and in-service engineering and logistics support. PEO(T) comprises a senior staff and ten program offices. Mr. Florip has served as counsel to PEO(T) since 2021.

Mr. Florip began his career with the Department of the Navy, Office of the General Counsel (OGC) in 2008. He was assigned to NAVAIR as a program attorney providing acquisition, contracting, and fiscal law advice for various PEO(T) weapons systems programs from 2008 to 2014. Mr. Florip then transitioned to supporting programs under the Program Executive Office, Air, ASW, Assault, and Special Mission Programs (PEO(A)) portfolio from 2014 to 2019. In 2019 he transferred to a Supervisory Attorney position at the Naval Air Warfare Center Aircraft Division (NAWCAD) OGC, a field office of the NAVAIR OGC co-located in Patuxent River, Maryland, where he served as the office's lead acquisition, contracting, and fiscal attorney and also practiced in other areas including civilian personnel law, ethics, and the Freedom of Information Act.

Mr. Florip received his Bachelor of Arts degree with Distinction in History and Political Science with a minor in German from the University of Michigan in 2005. He received his Juris Doctor degree Magna Cum Laude from Ave Maria School of Law in 2008, where he served on the Editorial Board of the Law Review. Mr. Florip is a recipient of the Navy Meritorious Civilian Service Award and has been nominated three times for the Navy OGC Acquisition Law Achievement Award. He is a member of the State Bar of Michigan. Born and raised in northern Michigan, he now lives in southern Maryland with his wife and two daughters.
