Mr. Samora graduated from the United States Naval Academy with a Bachelors of Science Degree in Mathematics. He also holds a Masters of Science in Mechanical Engineering from the Naval Postgraduate School, a Juris Doctor from California Western School of Law and a Master's of Law, LL.M, in Intellectual Property from George Mason School of Law.
