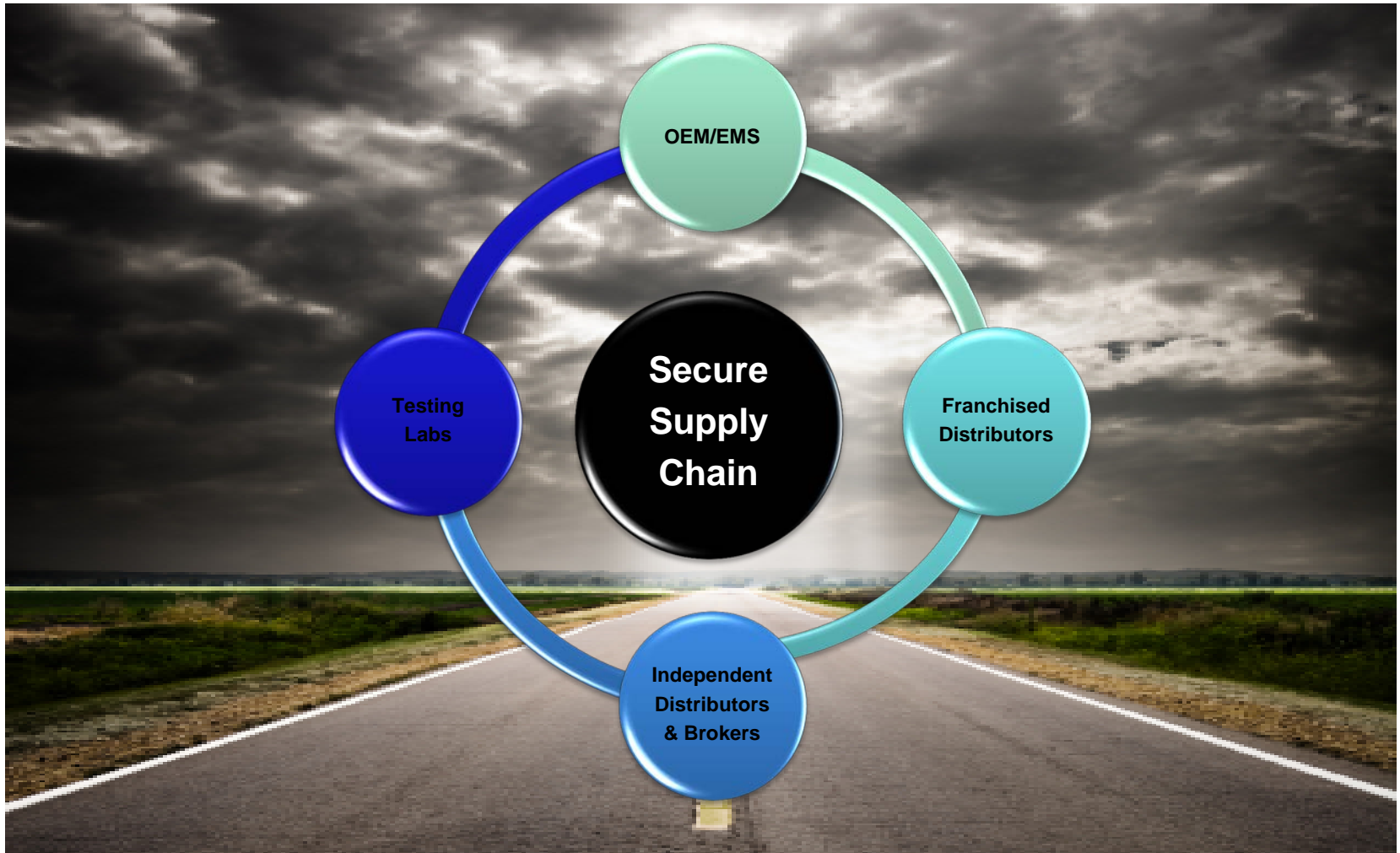

“Challenge”

Definition of Counterfeit Parts

Under the proposed regulations, a counterfeit part is:

- An unauthorized copy or substitute part that has been identified, marked, and/or altered by a source other than the part's legally authorized source and has been misrepresented to be from a legally authorized source
- An item misrepresented to be an authorized item of the legally authorized source
- A new, **used, outdated, or expired** item from a legally authorized source that is misrepresented by any source to the end-user as meeting the performance requirements for the intended use



Urge for Continued Communication!

Goal

- Implement a QMS that results in a Secure Supply Chain and Compliance

Road to Success

- Talk to your supply chain partners before implementing a QMS - This is a not a solitary mission!
- Once the QMS is implemented, Audit your suppliers onsite.
- Measure your supply base regularly and encourage QBR's.
- If a challenge arises, take immediate corrective action.

Recommendations

- Review the definition of “Counterfeit Components” and consider removing the words [used, outdated or expired]
- Align your company with the many industry resource organizations available
- Always share your data, expertise and know-how to achieve a continued Secure Supply Chain
