

BETA.SAM.GOV

beta.SAM.gov launched in Q4 FY17 and will coexist with SAM.gov

Current operational systems will run in parallel to the beta site and **will remain the authoritative sources** until they are decommissioned

beta.SAM.gov to eventually become SAM.gov


beta.SAM.gov Highlights

The primary focus of the modernization thus far has been integrating the original websites and preparing to decommission them

- Moved to a modern, secure, scalable technology stack
- Consolidated redundant features - created efficiencies
 - Ex: single-sign-on, role administration
- Standardized user experience
 - Ex: search, data entry

How to be ready when WDOL is turned off

- Monitor the WDOL.gov website for announcements about the transition
- Create a beta.SAM.gov account today
 - Follow wage determinations
 - For federal users, create and manage Collective Bargaining Agreements (CBA)
- Practice searching for wage determinations using the filters or by WD number



Wage Determination Subscriptions

Subscriptions will not be migrated from WDOL.gov to beta.SAM.gov

- Called “Follow” on beta.SAM.gov
- Requires a user account (this is new)
- Supports email and “in-app” notifications



How to be ready when CFDA is turned off

- Keep your legacy username and password up to date
- View your assistance listings from the public search
- Create a beta.SAM.gov account today
 - Migrate roles from CFDA.gov
 - Prepare role assignments for your agency (assistance administrators only)
 - View your assistance listings in the workspace
- Monitor the CFDA.gov site for announcements regarding the transition



Roles and Permissions

- To get a role, you will create a new account on beta.SAM.gov
- There are 3 ways to get a role
 - You may migrate a role from a legacy system
 - Some (typically non-administrative) roles may be requested
 - You may be assigned a role
- Roles are assigned by domain (data set) and organization
- Role management and permissions for industry are still under development



Role Migration

- To get a role, you will create a new account on beta.SAM.gov
- You will need your legacy system username and password for each system you migrate
 - Make sure your legacy password for each system is up-to-date
- If your current sub-tier or office is not active in the modernized federal hierarchy, you will need to request a new role
 - A small number of cases

Assistance User (may be requested)

Wage Determinations Roles

None

- All federal users can manage Collective Bargaining Agreements
- All other features are public



Where to go for help

beta.SAM.gov has two primary approaches for getting help: the Learning Center and Contextual Help

The Learning Center provides searchable, online articles, FAQs, definitions, and videos

- Finding the help you need is search-driven
- There are no PDF or other user guides
