SUBJECT: Product Service Code to Object Class Code Crosswalk, Version 2.1

Reference: Office of the Under Secretary of Defense (Comptroller) and Office of the Under Secretary of Defense for Acquisition, Technology, and Logistics joint memorandum, "Publication and Distribution of Final Product Service Code to Object Class Code Crosswalk, Version 2.0," March 4, 2016

This memorandum announces the publication of version 2.1 of the Product Service Code (PSC) to Office of Management and Budget Object Class Code (OCC) crosswalk, which was originally published April 14, 2014, and updated via the referenced memorandum.

This crosswalk improves alignment between execution and budget data by allowing visibility into the relationship between acquisition and financial commitments, obligations, and expenditures. The new updates realign some PSC to OCC mappings, and update PSCs to ensure alignment with recent updates to the PSC Manual, managed by the General Services Administration (GSA). The Department of Defense Financial Management Regulation, Volume 1, Appendix A, requires every purchase requisition and commitment recorded by the DoD be coded with an OCC and PSC. The Defense Federal Acquisition Regulation Supplement Procedures, Guidance, and Information segment 204.7103 requires the use of PSCs on contract line items.

The updated crosswalk is available at <https://psctool.us/references>; and the PSC Tool (<https://psctool.us>) itself has also been updated. The PSC to OCC crosswalk will be reviewed annually and updated as per the procedures outlined in the GSA PSC Manual found at <https://acquisition.gov/psc-manual>.
