SUBJECT: Publication and Distribution of Final Product Service Code to Object Class Code Crosswalk, Version 2.0

Reference: Office of the Under Secretary of Defense (Comptroller) (OUSD(C)) and OUSD for Acquisition, Technology and Logistics Memorandum, "Publication and Distribution of Final Product Service Code to Object Class Code Crosswalk, Version 1.0," April 14, 2014

The Offices of the Under Secretary of Defense (Comptroller) (OUSD(C)) and OUSD for Acquisition, Technology and Logistics published the initial version of the Product Service Code (PSC) to OMB Object Class Code (OCC) crosswalk, on April 14, 2014, referenced above, and available at <http://www.acq.osd.mil/dpap/policy/policyvault/USC000365-14-DPAP.pdf>. This memorandum announces the publication of the crosswalk to be used in Fiscal Year 2016 and beyond, and establishes a framework to future updates.

The updated crosswalk defining the relationship between the OCC and the PSC for commercial purchases is available at http://www.acq.osd.mil/dpap/pdi/p2p/improving_transparency_of_procurement_spend.html. In addition, the Product Service Code Tool has been updated for the crosswalk changes and is available at <https://psctool.us/>.

The PSC to OCC crosswalk will be reviewed annually during the third quarter of each fiscal year. Changes will be coordinated through financial and acquisition offices in the fourth quarter for September publication.
