
SUBJECT: Contractor Past Performance Assessment Reporting – 1st Quarter FY 2013

The Acting USD(AT&L) memorandum dated November 18, 2011, "Past Performance Assessment Reporting," tasked the Director of Defense Procurement and Acquisition Policy to monitor and communicate compliance information on past performance reporting to the senior procurement executives on a quarterly basis.

The PPIRS compliance metrics review for the first quarter identified the average in the Department as 67.5%. When compared to the previous quarter, this is an increase of 1.5%.

The attached spreadsheet identifies specific agencies with their overall scores for the first quarter of FY2013 as of December 27, 2012. There are only four agencies that have a percentage of 80 or higher and three in the 70 percent range. The Office of Federal Procurement Policy is planning to recommend 100% compliance by FY2015. The Department must improve the completion of contractor performance assessments.
