SUBJECT: DFARS Clause 252.204-7000, Disclosure of Information

The purpose of this memorandum is to remind contracting officers to respond promptly to contractor requests for written approval to disclose information pursuant to DFARS clause 252.204-7000, Disclosure of Information. For the purpose of consistency across the Department, contracting officers are specifically encouraged to provide a prompt, affirmative approval when a contractor requests approval to disclose information to United States Government agencies, such as the Department of Justice and the Federal Trade Commission as part of a review under the Hart-Scott-Rodino Antitrust Improvements Act of 1976 (15 U.S.C. 18a).
