SUBJECT: Accessing the New Wage Determinations Capability in Beta.SAM.gov

On June 14, 2019, the General Services Administration (GSA) will implement a new capability in Beta.SAM.gov to search for and download wage determinations as required by Federal Acquisition Regulation subparts 22.404 and 22.1008. At the same time, the legacy Wage Determinations On-Line (WDOL) system will be retired. Users attempting to access the old <https://wdol.gov> website will be redirected to the <https://Beta.SAM.gov> website.

To use the new capability at Beta.SAM.gov, users need only to navigate to the Wage Determinations domain using the search bar on the homepage. Search tools are then used to filter to the wage determination needed. Users are not required to have an account to access wage determinations in Beta.SAM.gov; however, they will need to establish one to “follow” any wage determinations and be notified when they are updated. Frequently asked questions (FAQs) about using the capability are found on Beta.SAM.gov under the “Learning Center” link. None of these system changes alter the requirements from FAR part 22 regarding use of wage determinations. Questions pertaining to the application of contract labor standards or the selection of appropriate wage determinations for specific contract actions should be referred to the contracting officer or to the designated agency labor advisors.
