SUBJECT: Rescission of Class Deviation from Implementation of the Electronic  
Subcontracting Reporting System

The subject class deviation, DARS Tracking Number 2008-O0004, dated  
June 3, 2008, is hereby rescinded. There is no longer a need to deviate from the Federal  
Acquisition Regulation since, as of October 1, 2008, the Department has begun full use  
of the Electronic Subcontracting Reporting System (eSRS).
