
SUBJECT: Contractor Past Performance Assessment Reporting – 2nd Quarter FY 2013

Implementation of contractor past performance compliance is a focus of the Office of Federal Procurement Policy as identified in its memorandum of March 5, 2013, and is of importance to the USD(AT&L). I am tasked with monitoring and communicating how the Department is performing on a quarterly basis.

The Past Performance Information Retrieval System (PPIRS) compliance review for the second quarter found the Department is now at 73.58%, an improvement of 6.06% from the first quarter. We are required to meet an 85% goal for this fiscal year and therefore must strive to meet a target of 80% for the third quarter and reach 85% by the end of this fiscal year.

The attached spreadsheet identifies the PPIRS compliance metrics as of April 1, 2013. The contract count identifies contracts from the Federal Procurement Data System that meet the DoD threshold. Remember that contracts must be registered in the Contractor Performance Assessment Reporting System for contractor performance evaluations to be completed.
